



Sun cream Policy

A Flying start Nursery provides children with plenty of opportunities to play outside throughout the year, in the summer months it is important to apply sun cream to the children before they go outside. It's the policy of A Flying Start Nursery to gain parent/carers permission before applying sun cream to a child, by means of a consent form in our registration pack.

Procedure

- Every morning a member of staff will check the UV levels on met office weather, The UV levels are displayed in both pre-school and toddler area's for all staff and parent/carers to see.
- We take precautions when going outside depending on the UV levels each day, using a guide from the met office.
- All staff are aware that we need a permission form from each child's parents/carers before applying sun cream, which is completed in each child's registration pack.
- The nursery supplies the sun cream for every child.
- In the case of a child who has an allergy we would ask the parent/carer to provide sun cream for their child and have their name printed on the bottle. This will ensure that sun cream is only used by that child.
- Staff apply sun cream in the morning before going outside and again in the afternoon.
- We record who and when the sun cream has been applied and each staff member signs.
- We reapply sun cream when;
 - ✓ Children have eaten
 - ✓ Children have had their faces/hands wiped
 - ✓ A child has been for a sleep
- Parents/Carers will be encouraged to bring in a sun hat (with neck cover) for their child.
